1. Planning & Permits

- Echeck local building codes and HOA regulations
- Obtain necessary permits
- Verify shed size, setbacks, and height restrictions
- Call 811 to locate underground utilities

2. Site Preparation

- Clear and level the site
- Install a compacted gravel pad or concrete foundation
- Ensure proper drainage slope away from site

3. Tools & Materials Checklist

- Power drill and driver bits
- Level and measuring tape
- Galvanized or weather-resistant screws
- Caulk, sealant, and weatherproof paint
- Shed instructions or blueprint

4. Assembly & Installation

- Follow step-by-step assembly instructions
- Ensure doors and windows are square and level
- Anchor the shed securely to foundation
- Install roof panels or shingles per guide

5. Weatherproofing & Finishing Touches

- ■ Seal corners, joints, and roof seams
- Paint or seal exterior surfaces
- Add vents for airflow to prevent moisture buildup
- Install gutters or gravel perimeter for drainage
